

## Mudhens Sept. 18 - get ready!




Catch a lasting memory when you join in on the fun of Senior Day with the 'World Famous' Toledo Mud Hens on Wednesday, Sept. 18.

## Trip activity levels

The following is an explanation of the levels assigned to the trips.

**LEVEL 1 – Minimal walking through parking lots and drop off** locations. Standing while waiting in line and for entrance to tours. Will include steps and uneven surfaces throughout day and steps in and out of motor coach.

**LEVEL 2 – Moderate walking/standing, up to half a mile, may include** stairs and/or uneven terrain. Plus on and off motor coach more than once.

**LEVEL 3** – Lots of walking/standing for multiple hours. May include flights of stairs and/or uneven terrain. Could include long days.

**LEVEL 4** – Extensive walking/standing, climbing stairs or hilly walkways and/or extended weather exposure.


