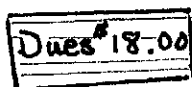

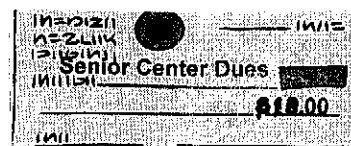
WINTER WEATHER

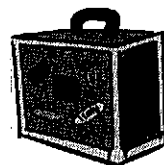
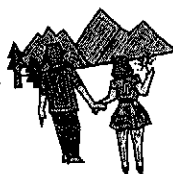
MEMORIAL

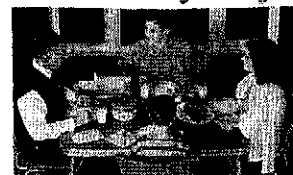

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR!

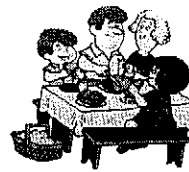

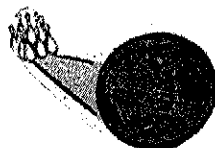

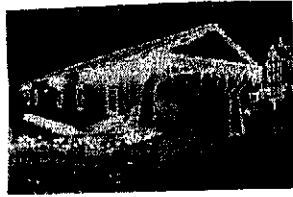

Senior trip to Clifton Mills

Wow! Can you imagine three and a half million lights in a Christmas display? 48 seniors from Bluffton Senior Center departed Dec. 4 ten minutes early (that's how excited we were) on a lovely Excursions motorcoach – I guess we're not supposed to call it a bus -- to see if the Clifton Mill lighting display was all that it's cracked up to be. And it was great.

To entertain us along the way Bob and Bev Painter had prepared a contest about Christmas movies, songs, etc. (Who knew that the Little Drummer boy's lamb came back alive?) Those smarter than me and all the others on the bus were Carol Smith, Sharon Hamilton, Nancy Knitz, Ruby Mabry, Marilyn Lenhart and Leanna Fruth.

Our bus driver, Tim, delivered us safely to our first stop, which was Young's Jersey Dairy Barn near Yellow Springs for an early dinner. The wait staff at the restaurant easily handled our orders for beverage, choice of ham steak or chicken and a scoop of their famous, extra-yummy ice cream. As we were preparing to leave a group twice our size arrived for dinner!

We arrived at Clifton Mill just after dusk and Bob had made arrangements for us to park the bus near the entrance so we didn't have far to walk. It was getting dark so there wasn't much to see. By 6 p.m. all that changed!

Viewing 3.5 million lights is hard to explain. It's still hard to fathom. It was actually easy to be overwhelmed. Once they turned on the lights for the mill, covered bridge and animated miniature village, the PA system announced they would turn the lights off in one minute and I wondered, "is this it?" No, it was about to get more awesome. They turned off the main lights to start the musical covered bridge light show. The lights danced and winked in time to a Manheim Steamroller Christmas song. The only disappointment was when the music stopped!

Still, there was more to see after that. After wandering around trying to get a better view of the pretty mill, the scenes in the miniature village (including the tiny marching band performing "Script Ohio") I wandered into the Santa display. The Satariano family (owners of the mill) have been collecting antique Santas for more than 47 years. Most of the items on display are from the 1940s to the 1970s. It was interesting to see how the image of Santa has evolved over the years. There were lots of Santa figures that wiggled, waved and made various sounds, including snoring. The employee on hand at the display said there are over 3,400 Santas and the collection keeps growing. Many have been donated. I even spotted a winged Santa which I am sure was donated by Bluffton artist Min Lindsey.

Viewing Santa's workshop through the window, I was surprised to see what I thought was a life-size Santa figure get up and walk over to the chimney and disappear through the hearth. Then I heard the people behind me oohing and Santa shout "Merry Christmas" from his perch on top of the roof inside the chimney.

The mill itself is not open for viewing but you can see the moving water wheel pretty close from the porch outside the restaurant. The gift shop not only had interesting things to buy but there were antique on display high in the rafters. I noticed later that the brochure available at the entrance had a page identifying the 37 items on display.

We left after the second showing of the covered bridge light show at 7 p.m. Those who didn't want to see it again got first dibs on Bev Painter's yummy cookies and then it was back home enjoying the Christmas music playing over the bus's PA system and viewing the residential Christmas displays as we traveled through Yellow Springs, Springfield, Urbana, West Liberty, Bellefontaine, Kenton, Ada and finally Bluffton.

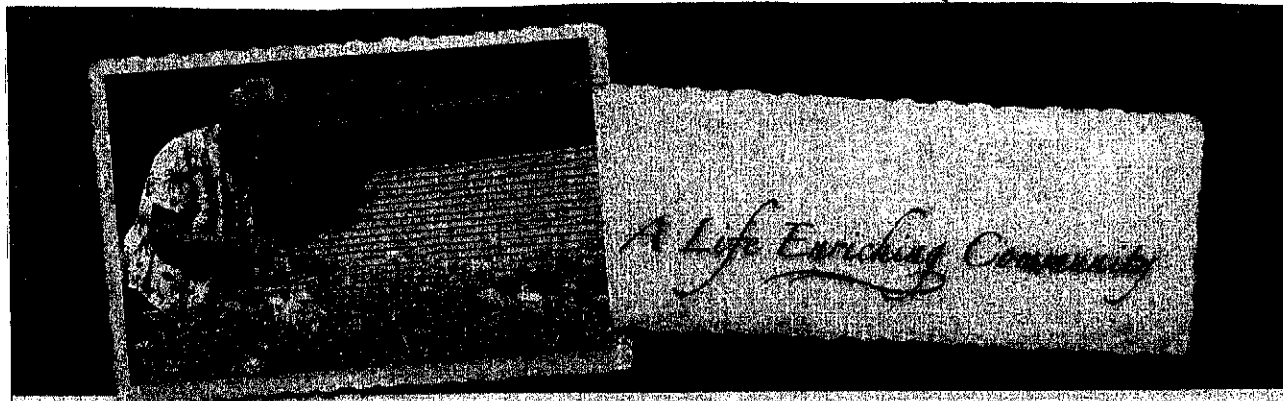

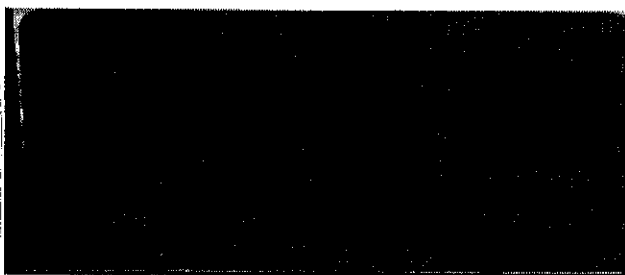
