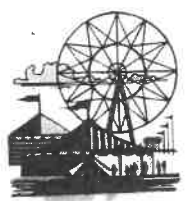
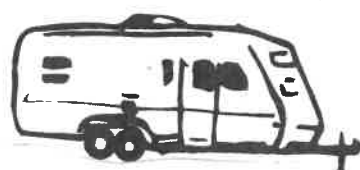
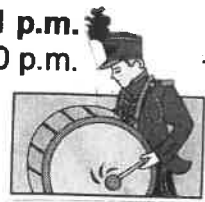

MOVIE TIME



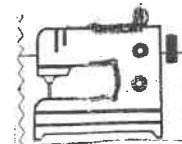

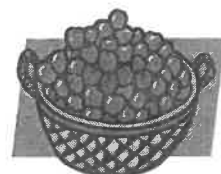

**JUNE DINNER MEETING**

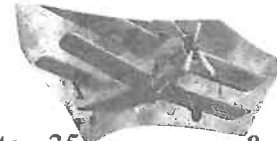
