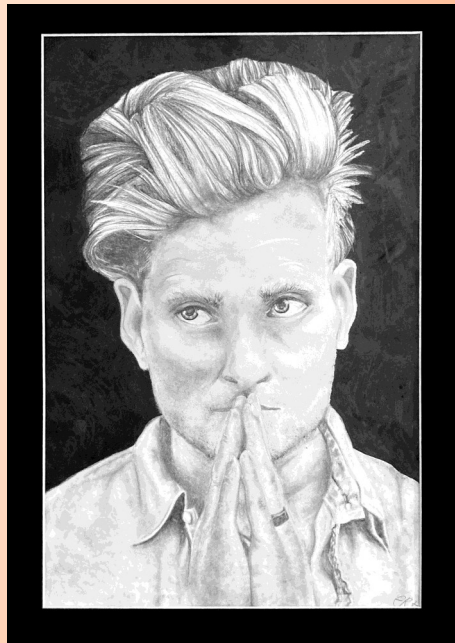
Michael Bendele
