Change certainly defines my life. Holding down a family and a music career involves more challenges, surprises, and changes than any person could ever want. Yet through it all, I've learned to lean on Jesus Christ—the one Person who never changes—for comfort and direction.

I grew up in a Christian home in Cincinnati, Ohio, listening to Amy Grant—and imagining one day having my own recording career. I'll never forget what my sister once told me. She came to me one morning and said, “I had a dream. In it, you were on stage singing with Amy.”

My response: “Yeah, right—whatever!” Then I sort of put it out of my mind. But a few years later, my sister's dream became reality. After I signed my first recording deal and released my first album, *Don't Let Me Go*, I received a phone call from—guess who? That's right—Amy Grant's managers!

They asked if I'd audition for her Heart in Motion tour. So I did, and they liked me—and the rest, as they say, is history. My life began to change in dramatic ways. Not only did I get to tour with my favorite singer—I was a backup vocalist and choreographer—but my own music career really began to take off.

Many years later, my greatest goal as an artist is something that has

never changed: I want people to walk away after my concerts feeling excited about their faith. I want them to see the world from a new perspective—God's perspective.

I want people to see that I have hurts and struggles, too. But I've learned to pick up and move on. Through it all, God is always faithful.

Practical Solutions for Busy Lives

(simple celebrations)

Chicken Tango

Yield: 6 to 8 servings

Everyone loves sweet-and-sour chicken and this colorful entrée looks like a party.

- 1 large (approximately 3 pounds) chicken, cut into 8 pieces or 6 boneless skinless chicken breast halves
- 2 bell peppers, roughly chopped
- 2 medium onions, roughly chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced or 2 teaspoons chopped garlic
- 1 can (20 ounces) pineapple chunks, drained
- 2 cups bottled barbecue sauce
- 1 teaspoon sliced, pickled jalapenos, optional

- Preheat oven to 375°.
- In a large (3-quart) baking dish, combine chicken pieces and remaining ingredients. Bake uncovered for 45 minutes or until largest pieces of chicken are done.

Need: 3-quart baking dish or 9" x 13" baking dish.

Cost Saver: Whole fresh chickens cost much less per pound than already-cut up chicken pieces. Buy prepared—pieces save time and energy.

Pro ahead Convenience items: Chop vegetables ahead and store in plastic bags in the refrigerator up to 3 days. Replace fresh vegetables with one bag (4 ounces) each, frozen chopped onions and peppers.

KIDS CAN TOO—As Mom gathers together the ingredients, kids can add them to the baking dish and stir.



GOOD IDEA
Serve Chicken Tango over rice, noodles or mashed potatoes. For a thrifty up-try this recipe using 6 large pork chops in place of the chicken.

MAKE IT MEMORABLE—This is a great recipe for company gatherings. Bake it up to two days ahead and then reheat in a 375° oven for 25 minutes or until hot and bubbly.

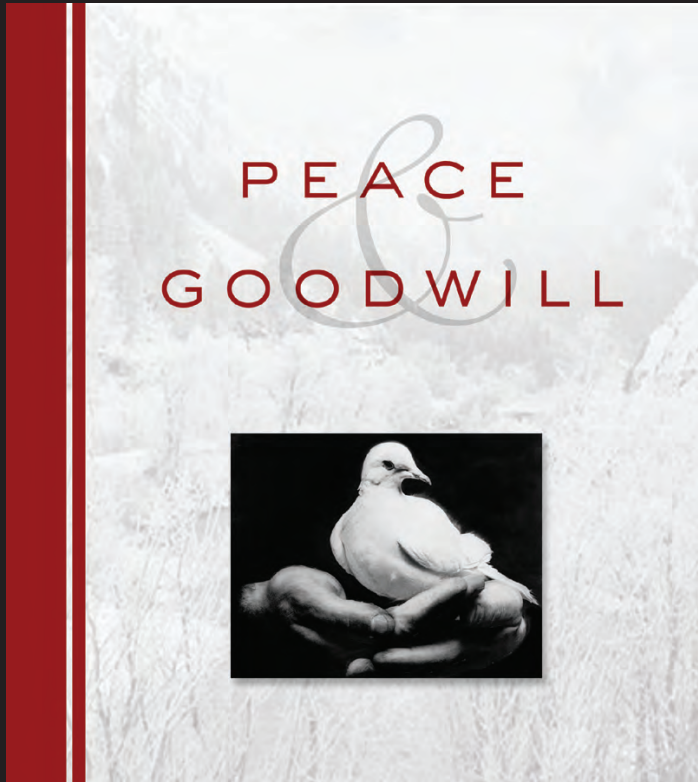
