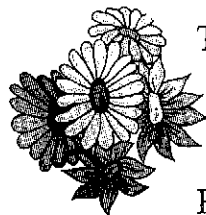
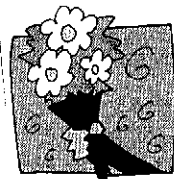

BLUFFTON ARTS & CRAFTS FESTIVAL Saturday, May 16th, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.



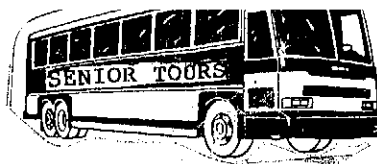

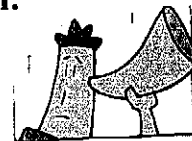


HEALTH INFO

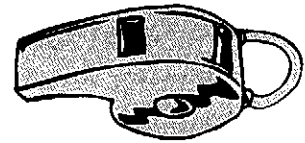
45 YEARS AND COUNTING UPDATE (new info, please read)

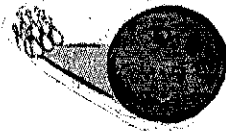
PACIFIC
