



Water bottle trip update

Trip activity levels

The following is an explanation of the levels assigned to the trips.

LEVEL 1 – Minimal walking through parking lots and drop off locations. Standing while waiting in line and for entrance to tours. Will include steps and uneven surfaces throughout day and steps in and out of motor coach.

LEVEL 2 – Moderate walking/standing, up to half a mile, may include stairs and/or uneven terrain. Plus on and off motor coach more than once.

LEVEL 3 – Lots of walking/standing for multiple hours. May include flights of stairs and/or uneven terrain. Could include long days.

LEVEL 4 – Extensive walking/standing, climbing stairs or hilly walkways and/or extended weather exposure.


