

MAY DINNER MEETING

A small group of 48 people got together on a humid May evening for dinner. Betty Moser and Ron Zimmerly decorated the tables with lilacs. Bob Painter opened the evening with a poem and a prayer. Betty and her friends served the group at the tables so people wouldn't have to get up. After dinner, Tonya interviewed Carolyn Green who turned 90 in May. After Announcements by the staff, Bob introduced Wendy Chappel-Dick and her daughter, Sara. Wendy played the guitar and mother and daughter harmonized beautifully. A good time was had by all.

SENIOR CITIZEN'S MYSTERY TRIP

Fifty-three travelers boarded the Buckeye Coach at 8:30 a.m. Thursday, April 24, all wondering where we would be going that day.

Our first stop was in Ada, Ohio, where the **Wilson Sporting Goods Co.**, is located. What do you see when you look at a cow? That was the question asked by our tour guide, with most of us said, "Hamburger or milk." He told us he sees 20 footballs, that is how many are made

from one cow hide. No, these footballs are not made with pig skin as most of us think. All the cow hides come from Chicago, Illionis, which are then either dyed a dark brown, which all the NFL footballs are made or a lighter tan, which all the Universities, colleges, and High School footballs are made.

Today, Wilson continues its strong relationship with football leagues around the world. Wilson football is the official football of the National League, the Canadian Football League, the European League, the National Collegiate Athletic Assoc. numerous Collegiate Conferences and a majority of State High School Athletic Assoc. The Wilson factory in Ada is the only football factory in the world dedicated to footballs ONLY, as well as being the only location in the United States where footballs are actually manufactured. The factory employs between 130 and 150 employees, produces between 3,000 and 5,000 footballs a day, and over 750,000 footballs each year. Most of these employees have longevity working for the company; and they retire when they reach the age of 60.

The dedication, innovations, quality materials, craftsmanship, and leadership by the **Sonnet family, Thomas E. Wilson, and L. B. Icely** are still the accepted standards that govern the manufacturing of today's footballs. The craftsman who makes them, the players that use them, and the company that sells them, know that the **Wilson** is the best footballs in the world. (Taken from the "**Wilson Co. History**"). My understanding is that every **Super Ball Game** uses 30 footballs. So the next time we watch a super ballgame, we can say we know where those **Wilson** footballs are made.

Our next stop was in **Hardin County** to see a **Dutch Deurzen Dairy Farm.** This dairy farm is owned by people from the **Netherlands.** They have 4,400 milk cows and have one of the largest carousal milking platforms in the United States. They milk 100 cows at a time, each cow is milked 3 times a day, which means they operate the milking machines 24 hours a day. It is highly computerized. Each cow produces approximately 9 gallons of milk a day. All the cows are artificially inseminated. The liquid manure is handled by a local farmer. This operation has 42 employees. Ohio has a number of these **Mega Dairy Farms** scattered throughout the state.

After lunch at the **Barn Out Back**, we headed back to the southeast side of Lima to a **Horse Farm**. A rider demonstrated the different steps and canters that a horse is taught to be eligible to become a show horse. The farm also had a number of other black horses that were a special breed, **Freisians**.

Our last stop was the **Allen County Museum & Historical Society** in Lima, Ohio. After a welcome and an overview of the museum, we were on our own to explore. The museums most recent expansion opened in 2010 which had exhibits on transportation. The **Lima Shay** locomotive located in the lower level was built by the **Lima Locomotive Works**. The **Shay** was used by the **Lima Stone Company** and donated to the **Historical Society** in the early 1950's. It was one of 2,761 **Shay engines** manufactured by **LLW**. The **Children's Discovery Center** includes a large model train layout which is very popular with kids of all ages. There were many interesting exhibits and I would encourage people to go and enjoy and learn from our past.




